

# Call for Tutorial

VCIP 2012 (<http://www.vcip2012.org/>) will be held in San Diego, CA, USA on 27-30 Nov. 2012. The VCIP 2012 Organizing Committee invites proposals for tutorials which are to be held on Tuesday, 27 Nov. 2012, the first day of VCIP 2012. Proposals for half-day or full-day tutorials encompassing state-of-the-art in visual communications and image processing related research and development are sought. Some topics of interest include

- Next generation High Efficiency Video Coding (HEVC) standard
- 3D TV, free viewpoint TV, multiview TV
- Video and image analysis and retrieval
- Mobile image/video and visual communication
- Social network applications with image and video
- Algorithm and architecture co-design for image and video applications
- Image and video surveillance, forensics, security and watermarking
- Immersive Visual Communication

The tutorial proposal should include the following in a one-column PDF file:

- Title of the tutorial
- 300-word abstract, keywords
- Format of tutorial (1/2 day or 1 day)
- Instructor(s) (with short bio for each instructor in IEEE format)
- Previous offerings of tutorial, if any
- Learning objectives, target audience, expected prerequisite knowledge
- Full description (1-2 pages)

The proposals will be evaluated based on the timeliness of the topic and relevance to VCIP 2012, as well as the qualification of the instructors.
